Both are pretty bad, but these kinds of things appeal to us. We would like to change our lives! And, we think intuitively that some changes are going to require some special power to pull off.

A rich irony for men and women: strength beyond any of these silly things is available right here and right now! It is free. And, God wants us to Have it. And to use it. You

might not know where it comes from, but here's a verse with which you are doubtlessly familiar: "The joy of the Lord is your strength." This verse is in Nehemiah 8:10.

we are talking about Great Joy in 2017. Jesus comes to



Milligan College Concert Choir, conducted by Dr. Noah DeLong

About the ensemble: The Milligan College Concert Choir is an auditioned ensemble that proudly upholds a long tradition of choral excellence within the Christian liberal arts context of the college. In the past, the choir has performed at the invitation of the President at the National Prayer Breakfast and also on international tours to England and Mexico. In addition, the choir has been invited to sing at the North American Christian Convention, the Conference on World Evangelism-National Missionary Convention, and at the Tennessee State Conference of the American Choral Directors' Association. In recent years, the choir has maintained an active performance schedule on campus and throughout Northeast Tennessee. Also, the choir travels frequently throughout the United States, with recent tours to Washington, D.C., and the mid-Atlantic as well as Chicago and the Midwest. In addition, the choir regularly collaborates with the Milligan College Orchestra, the Johnson City Symphony Orchestra, and the Symphony of the Mountains. About the conductor: Dr. Noah DeLong is a versatile musician who has found success as a conductor, educator, tenor soloist, collaborative pianist, and church musician. He holds the position of Associate Professor of Music at Milligan College, where he conducts the Milligan Concert Choir, an auditioned choir that regularly tours the U.S. and performs with regional orchestras. In addition, he leads Heritage, a select a cappella ensemble, and the Milligan Women's Chorale. He also teaches conducting, applied voice, aural skills, and secondary music methods, and is the faculty sponsor for Milligan's collegiate NAfME chapter. In addition, he regularly performs with the Tennessee Chamber Chorus, a professional ensemble based in southeast TN, and now serves as their Associate Artistic Director. DeLong earned the D.M.A. degree in Choral Conducting and Pedagogy from The University of Iowa. He also holds a B.A. in Music and Mathematics from Taylor University and a M.M. in Choral Conducting and Vocal Performance from Ball State University.

About the ensemble: Heritage is select a cappella ensemble of eight singers that maintains an active travel and performance schedule. The group, which was founded in 1983, frequently represents the college at churches, civic organizations, and college functions. Specializing in a wide variety of a cappella music, the group performs everything from modern worship music to Broadway, pop a cappella, spirituals, and vocal jazz.
