True, authentic freedom comes not from simply declaring you are going to do whatever it is that you want and then going after that full-bore. I would call that adolescence!

And freedom doesn't come either from the political world (thank goodness), or from music, or movies, or fashion, or face-altering surgery, or joining a fitness club, or getting back to nature, or starting going fishing or playing golf all the time (though writing those last two does give me pause...I do love to fish and golf!) Freedom isn't found in religion or no religion.
