LCC has a new mission! Jesus Place Inner City Mission is located downtown at: 1076 Longley Ave. NW, Atlanta GA 30318. Their mission is to promote Christ and His Church in the City through evangelism, discipleship and a variety of outreach programs. Since 1970, Jesus Place Inner City Mission has ministered to families in poverty and the homeless.

They offer several ministries that include:

- **Homeless Outreach**- Each Sunday, homeless people, many coming from the county shelter and the county jail, attend worship service and Bible study in NW Atlanta.

- **Fish House Recovery Program**: a 6-12 month program designed to encourage, equip and disciple homeless men with the goals of achieving quality employment, housing and restoration to family and active membership to a local church body. Their motto is "Fishing for Men, Equipping Men to Fish".

- **Tri-Cities Food Cooperative Program:** In collaboration with Tri-Cities Church, Fulton Co. Schools social workers and the Atlanta Community Food Bank, Jesus Place offers a food security ministry weekly.

- **Camp Christy:** Inner-city kids are taken to North Georgia for a week of impacting teaching and activities in God's creation. Camp Christy is named in memory of John's sister, Jesus Place's #1 volunteer who passed away in May 2004. Christy was an elementary school teacher and well respected by her colleagues and students. Sidewalk Bible School: They are willing as opportunities present, to partner with churches who agree to do a follow up work in doing outdoor Bible schools in needy areas throughout the city.

- **Internships**: Jesus Place invites Juniors and Seniors in college, as well as adults to participate in Summer, 8-12week, or year-long internships. Their goal is to expose and equip interns for future work in America's cities. Due to current financial challenges, interns must raise 100% of their living expenses/stipend.

Please pray for our new partnership and the opportunity to serve those less fortunate in our community.



Sundays and Wednesdays in the KUC

Our preschool to 2^{nd} grade Sunday School class will continue learning Bible Basics. The children are learning the books of the bibles and doing a review of each book. For our Wednesday night and Sunday Worship hour, the preschool/Kindergarten class and the $1^{st}/2^{nd}$ grade classes will continue going through bible. Our Later Elementary Class (3^{rd} to 5^{th} grade) are focusing on having a relationship with God.
