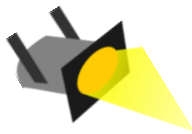

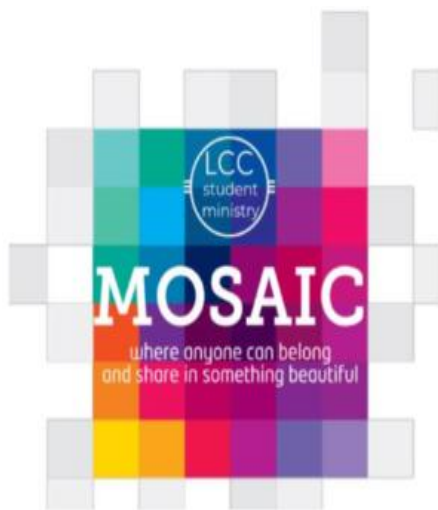

Missions Spotlight



Trash Mountain Project -AFE has been providing packets of food to families connected with their ministry. Overall travel in Honduras is severely restricted making extensive relief efforts difficult. Education has been impacted as well. AFE reports that university students have been taking classes online, allowing their education to continue but with AFE's classrooms closed, they began sending home school packets for the kindergarten through high school students along with food packets every two weeks.

Presently, AFE has spent more than \$15,500 in response to COVID-19. Of that amount, \$13,500 is money reallocated from their usual food and health care budgets since they have been closed for three months. The remaining \$2,000 was money acquired through donors. Please pray for the continued work of our Trash Mountain Partners in the midst of new challenges with COVID-19. Ministry is already difficult in these communities, so government restrictions complicate their efforts. Pray that God opens new possibilities for this ministry, the people working there and for their physical safety.



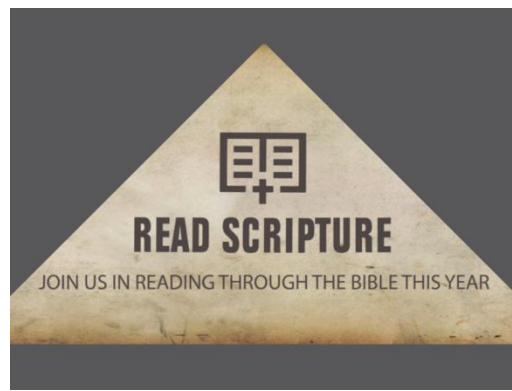
