NORTH GEORGIA CHRISTIAN CAMP

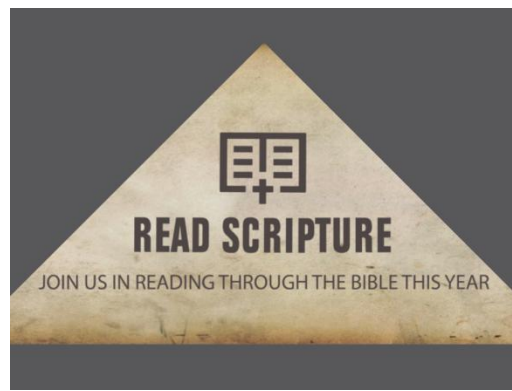


Partnering with parents to nurture
