And we need to be back. Online worship is marvelous- I praise God for it! It's kept us going for a year! But you can't beat being together in the flesh! We need each other. We need the Lord, of course; but we need each other. He reminded us of that all the way through the New Testament! There's 8 million "one another passages", remember those? are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching." (Hebrews 10:24-25) So I'm glad to be able to be back together! And I hope you'll join us when you are able!

More good news: Three of our people have "stepped up" in a big way to help us keep our ministries going!
