And, if you are not feeling well, worship with us Online on Sundays and Wednesdays! Sure, we're still wearing masks and distancing. But we're back!

And we need to be back. Online worship is marvelous-I praise God for it! It's kept us going for a year! But you can't beat being together in the flesh! We need each other. We need the Lord, of course; but we need each other. He reminded us of that all the way through the New Testament! There's 8 million "one another passages", remember those? 
