



MINISTER'S MESSAGE

You will notice that elsewhere in this newsletter there are lists of messages that are upcoming for Sundays and Wednesdays. Each of these messages has Scripture attached to them. That is by design. I learned to preach listening to and watching my Uncle Jim, and he always said, "Scripture, first." He meant, "Don't get a 'great idea', and then look for a passage that teaches that. No. The passage, the verses, must grab you first! You are then compelled to preach. To say what God is saying. Scripture first." He was right.

Christianity is a religion of the Book. It is more than that, of course. God's revelation of Himself to us is seen in many ways. In the Creation around about us. In our questioning minds. In secular records and writings, we find confirmation of the history the Bible proclaims. Romans 1 asserts, *"since what may be known about God is plain...because God has made it plain...For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse."*(Romans 1:19-20). His supreme revelation of Himself, of course, is found in Christ. *"In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe."*(Hebrews 1:1-2)

And the primary way we know about Christ is through the Scriptures. Certainly there's much in the Bible I don't understand. I can't explain all the Old Testament violence. Some New Testament passages cause disagreement in reputable interpreters. But what would we put in its place? The other religions that have "books" don't stand a chance! All of them are what C.S. Lewis said somewhere were "little boy's philosophies." The Scriptures, and the Savior they proclaim, are unique! The atheists are reduced, whether they like to admit this or not, to proclaiming, "From nothing...something!" How self-defeating is that?

So we hold to God's Word! We find Life here, and nowhere else. We find a Love we could only dream about elsewhere. We find food and sustenance that truly sustains and fulfills. Read Proverbs with us! Read about Jesus' New Wine with us! Here is the path of freedom! Jesus said He has come to bring us life and to bring it more abundantly. And how do I know this? John 10:10 teaches it! So, my brothers and sisters, let us continue to believe the Word, read the Word, feed on the Word! And, preach the Word.(2 Timothy 4:2)

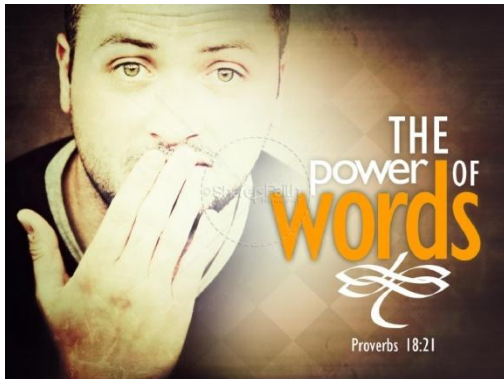
