The AFE clinic has been a greater help to the community than they normally would be because of Covid. It provides daily care to the students of their organization and their families in addition to serving the population of the dump communities in a significant way. Dr. Victor Quintanilla is available on a daily basis to attend to all patients who enter the clinic seeking help and medications. They have a nursing assistant (who was an AFE Graduate) in charge of triaging those who enter the clinic for medical consultation with the doctor. They're constantly monitoring the students for illness, etc. to ensure a safe 2021 school year.

They are starting modified in-person classes and continue to give thanks to God for taking care of all the students and their families. Please pray that their school year will be without illness from Covid and that everyone will remain healthy.

# Hear Ye – Hear Ye


### All Single Adults at Lilburn Christian Church
