MINISTER'S MESSAGE

Must! We all have a lot of musts in our lives. Expectations begin the cradle...and don't stop until our last day! People want all we have to give—and then want more still. You will remember that story in the Gospels when the people were grabbing and clinging, and the disciples were exhausted, everyone was hungry, and the 12 said, "Send them away"! Must! Some things are crucial and must be done. Crucial...

Did you know that the word "crucial" comes from the Latin word *cruci*, which means cross? Oh, and there are many, many crucial things about the Cross of our Lord Jesus! It's interesting how many times Jesus Himself used the word "must" to refer to some aspect of His going to the Cross. For instance, He said that He "must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things" (Matthew 16:21), and, "Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me" (Luke 24:44). These are all Crucial Musts!

And so that is the title of our Easter messages this year. I'd like to walk with you through Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John and listen to Jesus as He tells us all these Musts. And I pray that, as He does, and we hear Him, that His going to the Cross will mean that much more to us, that it will be even sweeter than it was before!

I pray that you and your family are well and will be able to join (or rejoin!) us for worship during these days! Dwayne and our Choir and Orchestra have marvelous, uplifting praise music to lift our spirits. I pray that for all of us it will be a season of joy and communion with our wonderful Savior!
