But to know that, as we are taught in Ephesians, that "He chose us in Him before the creation of the world" (1:4), is marvelous. A few verses later, we are again told, "In Him we were also chosen" (1:11), and this choice is for good. In fact, it is for better than good! The blessings we have showered all over us in Christ ("Lavished" is the word in 1:8), are so magnificent that we will spend the rest of our earthly lives trying to get a handle on them!


