## Missions Spotlight

### KERALA CHRISTIAN MISSION





**Sunday, Sept 4,** Rajan Ipe will be bringing the message on Sunday Morning from Kerala Christian Mission. Afterwards he will be providing an update to the LCC Missions team.

KCM has a wide reach in India with specific ways they are helping people there and spreading the Gospel. They have Youth Welfare Projects, Senior Home, Serenity Counseling Center, Training programs, Sports, Seminars & Camps, Child Development projects, Carmel Girls Hostel. They also serve to provide patient care to an average of 80 patients per day, in addition to Medical Diognostics. They also have a Medican and Surgical camp. This hospital has eight Doctors currently serving including consultants. This hospital was started by Rajan's father, Dr. Thomas Ipe in the early 80's. Lastly they also offer a retreat center in Vagamon. This serves the community by providing an auditorium, with seating capacity of 500 people. Also, there are various types of accommodation facilities in this serene location.



This past month I thought it would be a great idea to stay up all night with the youth group again. Hahaha.

The kids had a fantastic time. We had a few visitors as well.

We went skating, played "Underground Church", Hide & Seek. We ate sweets. Watched movies. We had a blast. I do these events to try to help the group grow closer together as a team. To learn to get outside of their comfort zone and try something new and make lasting, interconnected friendships.

I am so thankful for all my helpers who came out to support me throughout the night and in the morning with breakfast. Thank you so much.

The Missions Team has already paid for Shipping & Handling of our 100 boxes out of our missions funds. You will have the opportunity to have your box tracked to its destination. Watch for details when you return your box. Each label has a unique tracking number.
