MINISTER'S MESSAGE

Church Family,

April Fool's! When I was young, I would pull an April Fool's joke on my mother every year, and every year, she would fall for it. This gave not only me but my brother such glee.

The joke would be pulled on her every April 1st morning as we prepared for school. While my mother was in the bathroom readying herself for work, I would take the phone off the hook and yell that someone was on the phone for her. Like clockwork, she would emerge from the restroom and retrieve the phone with a confident, "Hello?" Of course, no one was on the other end. Still, she would repeat, "Hello?" several times while my brother and I laughed ourselves silly from the other room.

I would then appear, innocently asking my mother, "Who was on the phone?" Her response was always the same: "I dunno. I guess they hung up."

"April Fool's!" I would yell. "Doggone it, Peter!" she would retort with a smirk. "I fall for this every year!" Every year. Every morning. The same April Fool's joke. I tricked my mother into expecting to talk to someone on the phone. An anticipated outcome gone unfulfilled.

Have you ever been tricked into believing something or hoping for something to occur, but it went unfulfilled? Perhaps you were promised a birthday party that never happened, or maybe someone promised to meet you at a restaurant but were stood up. More seriously, maybe you promised your spouse in your wedding vows "to death to us part" but he or she ended up leaving you. Whatever the case, you were promised something, and it was never fulfilled.

Thankfully, God is not like this. When He makes a promise, it is guaranteed to be fulfilled. The Scriptures teach us that God is faithful. "Your lovingkindness, O LORD," says Psalm 36:5, "extends

to the heavens, Your faithfulness reaches to the skies" (NASB). God's Faithfulness is the idea of always doing what He says He will do. If God says it, it will infallibly come to pass. Speaking of God, Balaam prophesied to Balak in Numbers 23:19, saying, "God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent; Has He said, and will He not do it? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?" If God says it, we can take it to the bank!

One promise (among many) God has made to his people is He will save them from their sins and live eternally with Him. Recall John 3:16: "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (NASB). This is a promise! It is 100% certain! God has also promised to cause "all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose" (Rom. 8:28; NASB). God causes all things to work for good—no matter if they are obstacles, struggles, persecutions, or evil—for those who love Him and are called according to his purpose. This is not an "if" or wishful thinking. It is a promise!

Although we may not be able to have confidence in the promises or expectations of some people in this world, we can always be confident in God's promises! God is faithful and true. Remember this the next time you are tempted to waiver in your faith in God. He is no trickster. He doesn't pull April Fool's jokes.


